#### Worried?

Here at Stoke Hill, we are very aware that there may be times when families financially struggle during exceptional circumstances, a family crisis or extended school holidays. These are times when finances are often stretched to the limit. To help support you through these difficult times, we are able to issue foodbank vouchers, which we hope will ease the pressures of financing the weekly shop, albeit for a limited period.

In addition to standard food supplies, vouchers are available to exchange for fruit and vegetables, bread, basic toiletries, toilet rolls and occasionally cutlery items when available.

More recently, baby food and nappies can be supplied, however these will need to be preordered at the distribution centre.
