#### Punctuality

It is really important that all children arrive at school on time. If they are even a few minutes late on a regular basis it can have a negative effect on their learning, and on their classmates. Time is wasted repeating instructions and children who are late take time to settle.

At the Junior School the doors open at 8.30am and the register is taken at 8.40am. **If your child arrives after 8.40am they are late for school**. They need to go to the Front Office and sign in so we know they are at school.

At the Infant School the doors open at 8.45am and the register is taken at 9.00am. **If your child arrives after 9.00am they are late for school**. Families need to go to the Front Office and sign in so we know they are at school.

In the Nursery children are welcomed to their day between 8.45am – 9.30am
