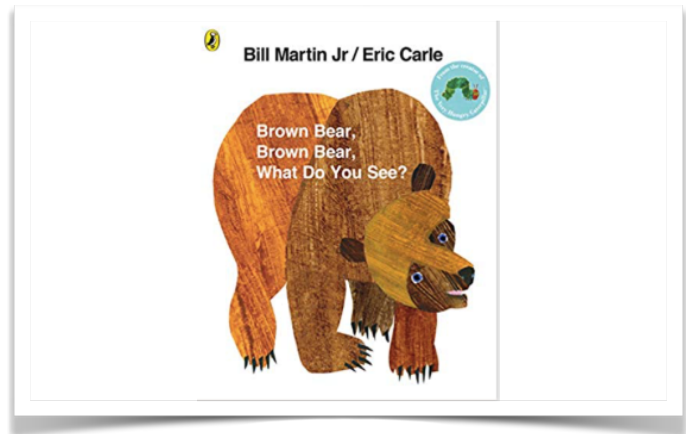


A Learning Letter from the Nursery School

Knowledge Organiser

Project

Our project this term centres around the theme of colour, inspired by the book 'Brown bear, brown bear what do you see?' by Eric Carle.

In the studio the children are exploring a different colour each week - learning about tints, shade, tone and creating their own names for the colours they have created.

Laura-Jane leads the learning for the projects and the children have the time to learn new techniques and become fully absorbed and involved.

Over the next few weeks the children will also be investigating how to design and create pop-up animals using card.



How you can help at home:

Ensure that ALL of your child's belongings, including shoes, are clearly named.

Encourage and teach your child to be independent by putting on their shoes and coats by themselves. Teach them how to put their shoes on the correct feet. Sometimes an arrow in the shoe helps as shown in the image opposite.
